

Dear Student,

The following is an explanation of each article of the Education Agreement (*Onderwijsvereenkomst*). Read the Education Agreement carefully, sign and return it as soon as possible. A parent or legal guardian must cosign if you are under age.

Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask for additional explanation. However, please note that only the Dutch version of the Education Agreement is legally binding.

Undersigned: includes your personal details and the school's data. Please check if the details are correct.

Article 1: shows name and details of your courses

Learning track

- Most of the training in the BOL program (*beroepsopleidende leerweg*, school-based learning track) takes place at school; professional training takes place during traineeships at a company or organization.
- The BBL program (*beroepsbegeleidende leerweg*, work-based learning track) combines study and work. Training takes place through learning by working at a vocational training company. One day a week on average, you will have theory lessons at school.

Level:

Vocational education courses lead to different final levels depending on what is required for the profession.

There are four levels of qualification. The duration of the training and the level or quantity of the material varies accordingly. The qualification levels of vocational education are:

- qualification level 1: assistant training
- qualification level 2: basic vocational training
- qualification level 3: professional training
- qualification level 4: middle management training and specialist training

Study load:

Study load stands for the average number of clock hours that a participant needs to complete the courses. These hours include taking courses, tests and vocational training.

When taking an accelerated course, the number of hours is less, which will be reflected in the start and end date of the course.

Article 2: refers to the regulations which apply at Mondriaan. These regulations include your duties, and your rights. Everyone is expected to abide by the rules, including you, your teacher and the director. The regulations are available at ROC Mondriaan's website (www.rocmondriaan.nl).

Article 3: refers to Vocational Training (*Beroepspraktijkvorming, BPV*). The BBL program includes at least 60% of this BPV-training, the BOL program 20% to 60%. BBL students must have a training place with a vocational training company (*BPV-plaats*) before January 1. Should you not manage yourself, you may ask the school to help you find one.

Article 4 and 5: stipulate your liabilities and those of the school and what can be done if you or the school do not adhere to the Education Agreement.

Article 6: stipulates when the agreement terminates. Should the term of the agreement expire before you have obtained your diploma, in most cases and under certain conditions, you will be able to complete your program. An additional agreement will then be signed.

Article 7: explains that the Participation Council has given its approval. Participants may become members of the Participation Council and join consultations on details of the Education Agreement and other regulations for participants.
